ABB Offshore Systems

1996-1999

During the first years in the company I worked with IT support of all kinds, plus IT administration. This Included everything from hardware, storage, network, design, installation, configuration, maintenance to troubleshooting, user & domain administration, application packaging distribution, IT architecture, design and build.

In later years also got administrative responsibility for the company's Messaging & Collaboration services (IBM/Lotus Notes&Domino), comprised of ca 8000 users worldwide and "some" TB of data. We designed and implemented server clustering for increased performance, real-time disaster recovery models. We were among the first to implement this model in Norway.

This job involved a lot of resource mapping, analyzing and planning, from hardware to Windows and IBM software level. I also was the main responsible for Security and anti-virus on the platforms plus staging and pilot environments. Plus key contact towards IBM.

During the later years in the company I set up and was responsible for ABB Group's collaboration pilots, which later became worldwide standards to be used throughout the company.

ABB Group

2000-2004

As Service Owner for ABB Ltd. Real time collaboration services I had responsibility for people/teams, hardware/servers as well as software. And functioned as main architect for service developments.

Aside of this I was also administrator and architect for a IBM/Lotus team collaboration platform. We delivered cross border collaboration services to ABB divisions, units and their customers, partners, suppliers and sub-suppliers.

I was also responsible for the group's collaboration services related to ABB's Divestiture and Acquisition department in Switzerland. Which meant a lot of Security related focus, from hardware/network to software. Plus project manager for IT several projects.

During this period I also resumed role as Architect and adviser for and in diverse projects in the group internationally, and continued to build on previously acquired competence to server the businesses. Was also tasked to collaborate with many ABB Clients and customers.

2004-2007

As ABB divested most of their Oil, Gas & Petrochemicals division I was part of the team to design and implement new data center IT architecture for the company in Norway and EMEA. This included network, hardware, windows servers, file and data structure, SAN and storage, clustering, fail-over and disaster recovery.

As the primary structure fell into place I was made responsible for provisioning, installation and configuration of the Messaging and collaboration infrastructure. Which included Windows servers, backup and disaster recovery, SAN and storage allocation/mapping and the IBM/Lotus server platform, Antivirus plus domain design.

We also built and used VMWare server infrastructure in any context where possible. I was also the main contact between the company and software vendor support teams, the guy who reported issues and requested fixes when necessary.

During a period of some weeks we successfully migrated approx 12,500 people out of ABB. As migration and in the period after I continued to function as IT Architect, adviser and Systems engineer.

I had responsibility for diverse services ranging from MS SQL/.Net based to Open source (PHP/mysql) and others. Plus instigated several pilots, one of which was related to advanced load balancing architecture.

As Vetco Gray was sold to GE Oil & Gas and Vetco Aibel acquired by other buyers i continued to work in Aibel with much the same roles, responsibilities and functions as previously had in Vetco International.

Was responsible for rebuilding/remodeling Aibels collaboration infrastructure, also to include internet services aimed at customers, partners and suppliers.

In 2007 Aibel outsourced all IT infrastructure and core services to BT and HP. I was employed in BT and given the role as Tower lead for Application, Messaging and collaboration services. This included responsibility for hardware (servers/storage), middle ware and key software platforms (IBM/Lotus and Microsoft). Plus the company's web internet and intranet web services.

Aside of this I continued to be IT architect and adviser, to both my old employer (now customer) as well as other BT clients throughout Scandinavia. I also functioned as Project Manager for several larger
